# 13 Music Notes

Today's anthem, "Advent Prayer", features a plaintive melodic line and a marvelous text. That text poses a question ("how will we know Him, Lord?"); happily, it provides several answers. But – as in many matters of faith – the answers can lead to further questions.

Those answers include all four of our Advent candles, each accompanied by references to light: "seek in the radiance of hope and of peace" "in the bright flame of joy' "in the light of love". But they also include an answer that, for me, leads to more questions: "seek Him first in your heart". What are we looking for there?

Perhaps one clue is in the hymn "Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus", which is also cited in this anthem. I recently heard that prayer restated (in my heart!) as "come, thou *unexpected* Jesus". The truth is, Jesus comes to us in many ways and at many times – often unexpected. "Seeking Him first in my heart" makes most sense when I keep my heart open to His coming, in whatever form that takes.

Advent is a time of preparation. Seek Him first in your heart – and be prepared for the unexpected!
